



## COVID 19 Return to On Campus Services Protocol Summary

Phase 1: Month of June

### Schedule

- Sunday Morning: One online and on campus services at 11:00

### What precautions are being taken for On-Campus Services?

- We are dedicated to providing a clean and safe environment for all worship service attendees.
- We will practice physical distancing at all times.
- Sunday morning service will enable us to limit our crowd capacity to 50% of our fire code capacity.
- Temps will be checked on everyone entering the builds as well as Covid-19 Screening questions.
- Hand sanitizer will be available on entering the building and throughout the building.
- We recommend, but won't require, wearing a face mask when entering and exiting the building.
- Our Welcoming Team (ushers, greeters, security, and Leadership Team) won't be shaking hands or making physical contact. We will be smiling and very intentional to make sure every attendee feels welcome.
- There will be no children or youth classes for any age group.
- There will be no one allowed in the lobby. This will help keep with social distance
- Children 12 and under will not be allow to go to the restrooms allow with their parent.
- We are asking families to sit together. There will be no children or youth allow to sit away from their family units.
- We will have a modified offering process to avoid passing the offering plates.
- At dismissal, PLEASE BE PATIENT, collect your items and wait for instruction on the exiting process. Please exit the building once instructed. This allows for the sanitizing process to begin so we are ready for the next service.

### Should I Attend?

We encourage you to follow recommendations from health professionals and make the best decision possible for your family. Take the precautions that you feel are necessary. We will support the decision you make.

Please take extra precautions if you fall within the following categories:

- You are over the age of 65 and have a compromised immune system.
- You currently suffer from cardio-pulmonary disease.
- You have a preexisting health condition.

We are also asking that you please stay home under the following conditions:

- If you are exhibiting any kind of symptoms of sickness or viral infection.
- If you have a fever with a temperature over 100F degrees.
- If someone in your home has symptoms or a fever.
